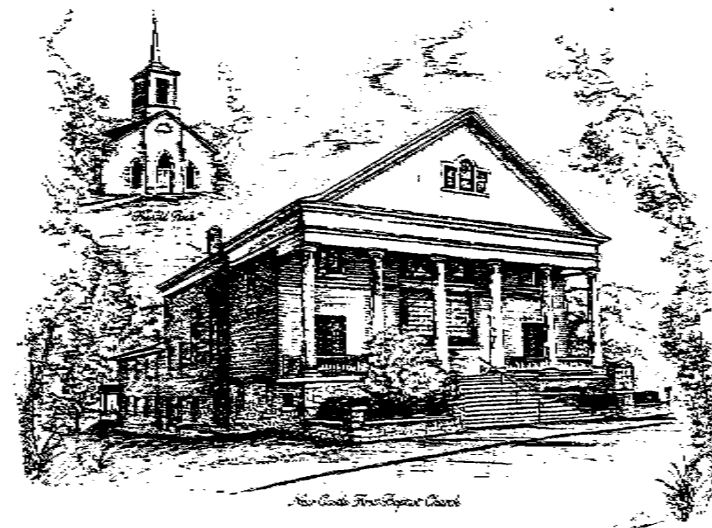
HOW TO JOIN THE CHURCH
